Carolyn Williams DeLille, age 91, passed away August 27, 2019 in Fayetteville, Arkansas. Ms. DeLille was born August 6, 1928, in Leslie, Arkansas to her late parents, Robert E. Williams and Lola M. Williams.

She graduated from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, where she worked for more than 25 years as the librarian in the chemistry department. During her more than 40 years in Fayetteville, she was a long-time member of the Friends of the Fayetteville Public Library, the 20th Century Book Club, and the Central United Methodist Church.
